These lands are hereby offered for oil, gas and associated hydrocarbons lease by competitive filing by the State of Utah, School and Institutional Trust Lands Administration, at a **16-2/3% royalty rate, 5-year term**, unless otherwise specified for the individual leasing unit, in accordance with the provisions of State law and the Rules Governing the Management and Use of Trust Lands in Utah. The offering of these lands for leasing of oil, gas and associated hydrocarbons does not guarantee that there are deposits of oil, gas and associated hydrocarbons on these lands. **The filing period ends at 5:00 P.M., Friday, October 25, 2013.** Each application should include only one leasing unit per application and must be on Form B (rev. 6/08), Oil, Gas and Associated Hydrocarbons Competitive Lease Offering Application, or copies thereof. Form B (rev. 6/08) must be accompanied by two checks, one for the bonus bid for the leasing unit and one check for \$30.00 to cover the application fee. All application fees are forfeited to the Trust Lands Administration. The minimum acceptable bid is **\$2.00 per net acre or fractional part thereof** unless otherwise noted. Each bid is for the first year of the lease.
